

Burnaby Horsemen's Association Policy: Stall Bedding Types

Approved: February 06,2024

Applicability

This policy is to ensure the manure sheds provide a high-quality garden product for local gardeners and to comply with the restrictions of our manure bin haul away contract.

Policy

Due to limitations in place in order to produce quality compost and to properly comply with the restrictions of our contracted manure bin haul-away company there are limitations on which types of bedding materials can be used at BHA. Stall sublessees are responsible for supplying their own adequate amounts of the approved materials to properly absorb urine for their horse.

The following materials can be used for stall bedding:

- Any type of softwood pellets
- Any type of softwood shavings
- Chopped straw (must be small, fine, commercially prepared products).
- Chopped Flax/hemp stalk/husk type bedding

The following materials cannot be used for stall bedding:

- Baled straw/Full length straw
- Hog Fuel
