Burnaby Horsemen's Association (BHA) 2026 Non-Riding Burnaby Membership Application

BHA's lease with the City of Burnaby requires Burnaby residents are given priority for stalls. The volunteer Board of Directors, which administers the association, reviews all membership applications at the monthly Board meeting. **Only after notification of acceptance, can the new member participate in barn activities.**

This form is for the Non-Riding Burnaby Membership only. **A Non-Riding Burnaby Member may only care for a horse or pony within the horse or pony's stall.**

NOTE: If you are interested in handling a horse or pony outside a stall, you must apply for full membership. BHA will only issue you a barn key if you are associated with a stall holder, and need independent access to the horse or pony at that stall.

To be eligible for this membership category you must be a Burnaby resident, and provide proof in the form of a BCID or BC Driver's License.

BHA Member Code of Conduct

In my role as a BHA Member I will:

1. Uphold and adhere to high standards of horsemanship, sportsmanship and interpersonal behavior.
2. Recognize that BHA is a diverse organization with members of different backgrounds, diverse disciplines of riding, training, and care. I will be accepting both of individual differences, and differences in horse care.
3. Recognize that BHA is a nonprofit, community-based organization dependent on continued subsidy for land and taxes from the City of Burnaby. I will act as an ambassador for BHA specifically and horse ownership in general with the public. This includes treating members of the public, guests, gardeners picking up manure, and other park users with respect, tolerance and consideration, as well as service providers, tradespeople on BHA business and employees of the City and Metro Parks.
4. Educate myself on and follow BHA policies, procedures and bylaws.
5. Follow national, provincial and municipal laws and bylaws at BHA. Recognize that the grounds of BHA are situated on the ancestral, traditional and unceded territory of the Coast Salish and Stó:lo peoples, including the kwikwə́ł əm (Kwikwetlem), xʷməθkwəy̓ əm (Musqueam), Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and Səlilwətaʔ/ Selilwitulh (Tsleil-Waututh) Nations and commit to learning about stewardship best practices from these nations.
6. Recognize BHA is a volunteer-based member-run organization, I will volunteer and participate in the democratic processes of the club.
7. Work to maintain a positive, welcoming community at BHA, and seek constructive avenues for solving interpersonal differences.
8. Not let personal interest or interpersonal conflict drive my decision making on BHA policy and procedures, either as a voting Member or in an elected position to BHA Board or Barn Committees.
9. Recognize that BHA has zero tolerance towards bullying, for both junior and adult members.
10. Recognize that BHA has zero tolerance towards any and all forms of discrimination towards members and the general public, including but not limited to racism, sexism, and homophobia, as set out in law.
