MANDATORY VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

Beginning January 1, 2026, the BHA Volunteer Program will launch requiring:

- Sr. Members to **complete & record ten (10) hours of volunteer work**
- Non-Riding and Junior (12 yrs as of Jan 1, 2026) members to **complete & record five (5) hours of volunteer work**

Hours will need to be logged via the **Track It Forward App**. For Senior Members, two (2) program choices available are:

OPTION A - please submit a \$250 cheque dated December 31, 2026, to be destroyed* upon completion of the 10 mandatory hours

OPTION B - please submit a \$250 cheque dated January 1, 2026, in lieu of the 10 hours of volunteer work to be cashed in January

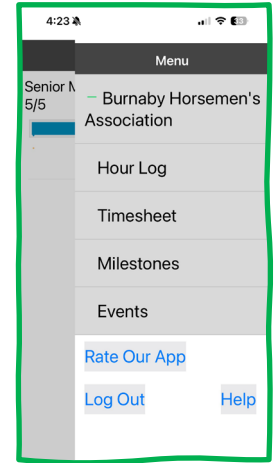
